

Homework Activities Year 3 Autumn Term 2017

In Year 3 we expect the children to do a number of small activities independently at home to support and enrich the topics we are covering in class. We thank you for supporting your child in these activities. Please tick or highlight the activities that have been done.

Reading - It is valuable for your child to read their reading book every day. We recommend 20 minutes a day sharing, reading and discussing the book, characters, pictures and storyline etc. This should include you reading to your child where possible.

Your child should bring their reading book and reading record book in to school each day and put this in their drawer when they arrive in the morning. Time will be given for the children to change their books at the start of each day choosing books from their colour box within the classroom. The children will not be choosing books from the library.

Maths - One activity a week has been provided in a grid for your child to do. These activities are mostly practical and fun and will support the maths work being done in school. There are also some Extension (Ext) Activities if your child would like a challenge.

Topic Work-The topic web shows you the areas of learning we are covering this term in school. The activities below will help to support this. Throughout the term try to complete as many of the activities as you can. The children can record their activities/research in the Homework Book. The teacher will collect the Homework Books during the week before half term to see how the children are getting on. These are only suggested activities so do not worry if you haven't got internet access or you are unable to do it all. Encourage your child to do their best and present work neatly. If you have any books, pictures, objects or know an expert that would be relevant to the topic, we would love to see them in school!
