

Literacy

- Reading – Reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts including texts including books, posters and adverts with a focus on retrieving information from the text to answer questions.
- Theme of texts: Taking Flight
- To identify key features of non-fiction writing and mimic this in their own work.
- Writing in role e.g. A character from a story read together.
- Using accurate sentence punctuation (commas, full stops, capital letters and finger spaces).
- To use headings and sub headings and introduce paragraphs to improve presentation.
- Improving skills for planning, proof reading and editing for effectiveness.
- To use question marks and exclamation marks.
- To revise nouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs and prepositions.

Maths

- To count up and down in tenths and relate this to equal parts and the equivalent decimals.
- To position fractions to 1 on a number line
- To recognise, find and write unit fractions.
- Arithmetic calculation – revising methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Science

Plant life cycles – processes germination, pollination, seed formation and dispersal.

Sorting and classifying – bird appearance and habitats

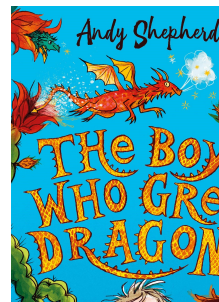
