

Year 4 document for home-learning in response to potential school closures as a result of Covid 19

Literacy

In literacy we have been learning about the Romans. We have learned how the Romans invaded Britain and were fought by Boudicca. We have also learned about Roman gladiators, the Roman army, Roman clothes and Roman foods.

The writing genres we have covered this year are: information pages, biographies, stories, poems, letters, and speeches. Children should plan and write a piece of writing about the Romans choosing one of the genres we have studied this year. Remember to include sentence openers, conjunctions, and good description, and to check spellings and punctuation.

In our grammar lessons we have been learning about suffixes and prefixes, main and subordinate clauses, tense, conjunctions and statements, commands, questions & explanations. There are plenty of activities to practise these on TWINKL, of which there is a free full membership link at the end of this page.

Maths

In maths we have been learning about fractions and decimals.
