

Literacy

Reading: Establishing book boxes and routines for changing books.
Reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts and answering questions about the characters, plot, setting or information presented within texts. - fortnightly comprehension
-Reading and exploring themes within stories - developing questioning and summarising skills.

Writing: Key texts lead the writing: Weslandia, After the Fall and Mudboy to explore key themes linked to emotions, returning to school/routines, friendships and developing and maintaining a positive outlook.
-Writing in full descriptive sentences & paragraphs, using conjunctions to join and to start sentences with appropriate punctuation.

Grammar: Conjunctions - Main and subordinate
Subordinate conjunctions linked to time to retell events

Spellings: Following initial assessment, children will spend the half term looking back to commonly misspelt year 3 words. Daily practise and games.

Maths

Place value: Partitioning numbers to 1,000 then 10,000
-Ordering and comparing 4 digit numbers
-Rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
-Positioning numbers on a number line - finding missing numbers to 10,000
-1, 10 and 100 more or less than a given 4 digit number
-Negative numbers
-Roman numerals introduction
-Addition and subtraction
