

Literacy

During this term we will be focusing on a key text called "Running Wild" by Michael Morpurgo. We will be using the story to learn about the tsunami that hit Indonesia in 2004 and produce explanatory texts about the science behind them.

We will also be reading and analyzing the story in our class reading sessions. The story will also lead onto comprehension based activities involving the poem 'The Tyger' by William Blake.

The children will have many opportunities to be creative in their writing, from narrative to poetry and non-chronological report writing.

Geography

We will be looking at what causes tsunamis and using atlases to locate places around the world that are most affected by these use waves.

We will continue to develop written and mental strategies for all four operations to improve speed and accuracy in our maths sessions as well as weekly arithmetic lessons.

During this term we will be thinking about which areas of maths are still a concern and we will try to revisit these before SAT's.

RE

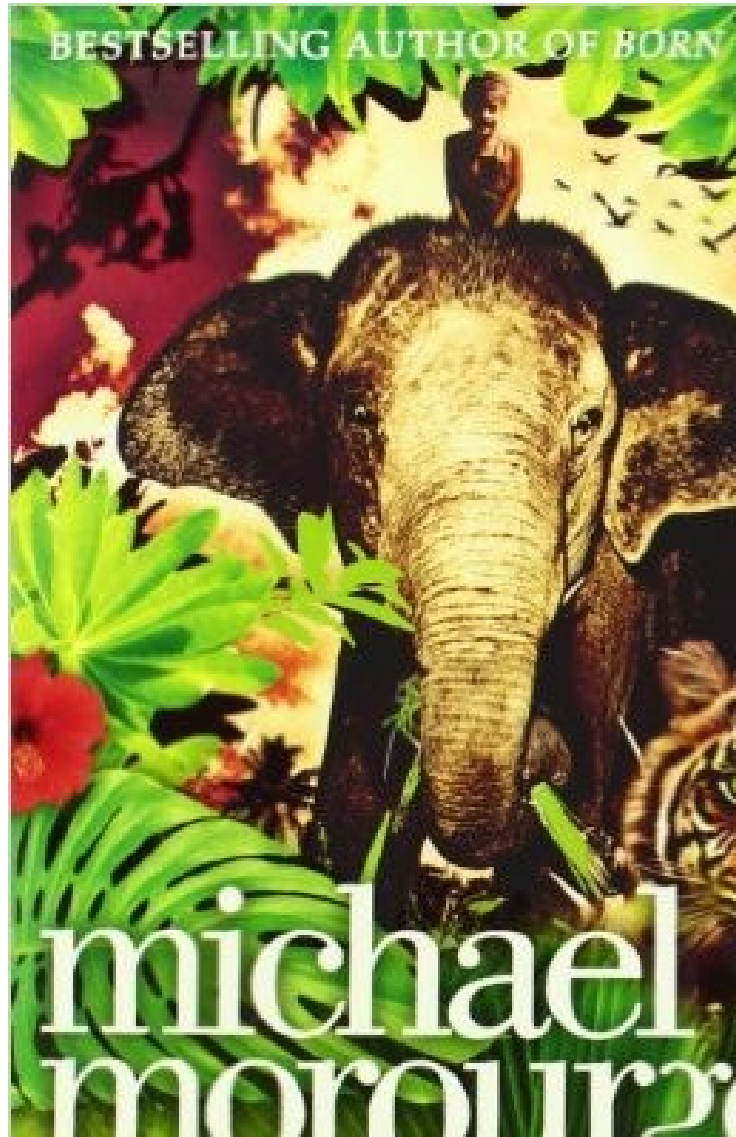
Our focus in RE is on Buddhism and exploring the key elements of the religion.
