GUIDANCE FOR PARENTS PARKING OUTSIDE OF THE SCHOOL

Where can I park?

You should park your vehicle in line with the parking restrictions in place, at all times. When arriving by vehicle to school, please leave sufficient time to park safely and appropriately and be aware of any parking notices fitted to the pavement.

Can I park on double yellow and single yellow lines?

You can only stop for a short period of time on double and single yellow lines to allow passengers to exit or enter your vehicle, providing no obstruction is being caused. Do not park on yellow lines directly outside the school as views can be blocked for pedestrians, especially children who are very vulnerable.

Can I park on school keep clear markings or zig-zag markings?

You must NOT park or even stop on school keep clear or zig-zag markings. This is an offence and carry's a fine of £30 or more.

School Safety Zone

There is a School Safety Zone outside of the school which is determined by flashing amber lights and an advisory 20mph speed limit sign – please reduce your speed limit outside of the school - it makes a significant difference to the overall safety of the children.
