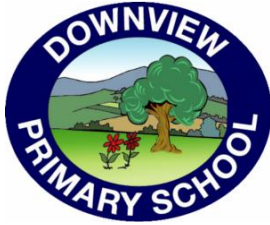


The PTA will be holding their Easter Event after school on Thursday 6th April after school (further information to follow).
